We believe hip hop dance provides an excellent outlet for creative expression through its choreography and free-style components.

The program is taught by a professional dance instructor.

At the beginning stages, choreography is more structured so that students can develop a dance "vocabulary" of movements to form a strong foundation.

Once confidence is built among the students, creative movement exercises are implemented to help participants begin to visualize, conceptualize, and create choreography by pulling inspiration from many different sources.



The goal is to be able to provide a physical form of art where, similar to a drawing class, students produce a work of art on their own and are able to take that with them outside of the "classroom."

Our aim is that participants feel proud of what they've created/accomplished, as well as find a personal voice and form of expression in dance.

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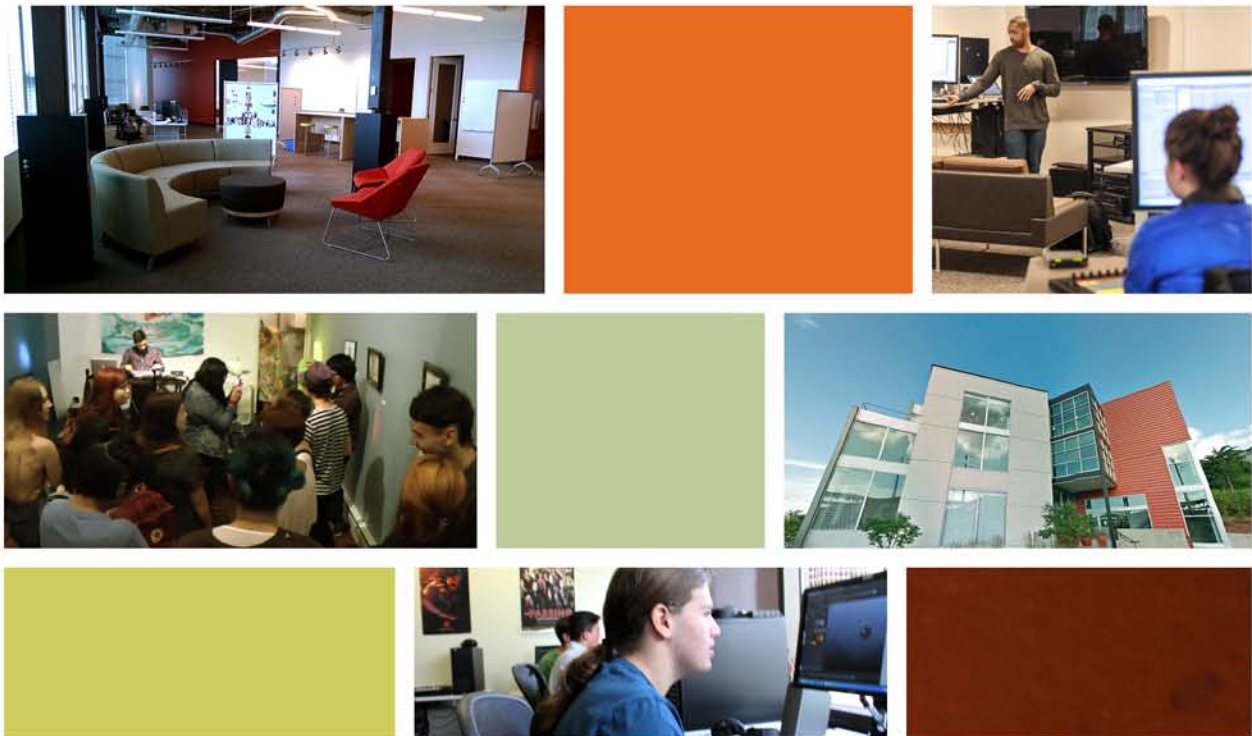
We are an education and research organization. We just moved into a cool, new space in Seattle and are **seeking student artwork to display in our new office.**

## PHILOSOPHY

Many teens have developed passions in areas not traditionally offered by school. We believe there is a lot to be learned by allowing them to pursue these interests.

We created our student-led internship program to provide such opportunities to motivated students. Student voice is essential to the design and development of our programs because we recognize that when given the opportunity, teens can take their ideas and create something real and tangible. The only problem was that they lacked the expert guidance and resources to actually make their ideas a reality. **That's where we can help.**



## STRUCTURE

The program begins with an application from a teen for a project they are interested in pursuing. You can apply on our website, linked below.

If the idea is approved, we then enter a phase of in-person interviews. A team from foundry10 will meet with the prospective interns to determine interest levels, workload, and team dynamics. The team will also be tasked with defending their idea and plan.

We supply the team with all the resources they need to complete their project. The team will be responsible for every aspect of their project, from setting deadlines to requesting resources and setting up mentor meetings. Professionals, experienced industry experts, and mentors may help develop the team's understanding of their project.

## AREAS OF INTEREST

While we are constantly expanding our network to serve more interests, some of the project areas we have supported include **film, video game design and development, video game modification, automotive technology, visual arts, performing arts, and audio production.** We are eager to hear ideas outside these realms to see if we can provide a great experience.



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

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
